

The Faculty of Protestant Theology at the Rheinische Friedrich-Wilhelms-Universität Bonn invites applications to the following position:

Professorship (W3) for Practical Theology

A starting date for this position of 1 April 2023 is anticipated.

The Faculty of Protestant Theology at the University of Bonn is committed to ongoing development of a profile in theological research that is relevant to the present and prepared to take intellectual risks. The faculty seeks a candidate for this position who is likewise committed and who is willing to contribute his or her expertise in research and teaching to new faculty and university-wide cooperations.

In addition to a doctorate and habilitation or equivalent academic achievements in the field of practical theology with a focus on homiletics, liturgics, or poimenics, qualified candidates will possess the ability and willingness to represent the subject of practical theology in teaching in its entire breadth, in all courses of study, and to do so in German as well as in English. The submission of a teaching concept with the application is expected.

In terms of research focus, it is expected that candidates will hold expertise in areas of digitized church and religious practice. The ability and willingness to engage in interdisciplinary cooperation, including projects in the Transdisciplinary Research Area "Individuals, Institutions and Societies" (TRA 4) of the University of Bonn are required. Successful acquisition of third-party funding is expected.

Requirements for employment are habilitation or equivalent academic achievements according to § 36 Higher Education Act of North Rhine-Westphalia (Hochschulgesetz NRW).

The University of Bonn is committed to diversity and equal opportunity. It is certified as a family-friendly university and offers a dual career service. Its goal is to increase the proportion of women in areas where women are underrepresented and to particularly promote their careers.
